- A panel review of the applications will be conducted. Panel members will remain anonymous, and will not be related to any member of Peak Athletics. The selection decisions made by the panel will be final.*
- Individual scholarship award amounts will be part of the panel evaluation.*
- Scholarship recipients will be announced during the October parent meetings.*
- Scholarship awards may be used for Peak Athletics Plus tuition, or team fees/assessments, uniforms, or travel expenses related to the athlete's competitive team.*
